1 Introduction

DNO Norge AS (DNO) will be conducting Permanent Plug and Abandonment (PP&A) on the Oselvar field and the Gomez exploration well with the semi-submersible drilling rig Borgland Dolphin. Planned start up is in end of March 2021.

A risk-based approach is applied for follow up of contractors and subcontractors and an audit, review, and verification (ARV) plan has been established to assure DNO that critical activities and services related to the projects are following contractual and regulatory expectations. The main goal is to ensure that DNO, contractors and subcontractors involved in the DNO operations, are competent to perform the activities in a safe and prudent manner.

As a part of the ongoing preparations for the upcoming activities, DNO performed a verification of ASCO on their planning and readiness related to their scope of work delivery, base and handling equipment services.

The verification was conducted 10th of March 2021 on Teams and with two persons from the verification team present at the base, cf. agenda and timing given in <u>Chapter 3</u>.
